They are used to being commanded constantly and I guess we are the first ones who have ever shown any interest in them as persons. We really have a time getting our ideas across to them and them to us. The one who does most of the cooking is really quite a comic. He keeps us laughing. We brag on his cooking and he just laps it up. I go over there and watch him cook something we particularly like and tell him Mr. Epperson wants me to learn to cook it so I can fix it in American and he really beams. Daddy says he always brings me the biggest and best portion of everything we have.
